1/ Poppet valves date from at least the 1770s, when James Watt used them on his beam engines

2/ Honda limited its initial investment in the production dies for the CB750 by using a technique called permanent mold casting (often erroneously referred to as sandcasting) rather than die-casting for the engines unsure of the bike's reception. The bike remained in the Honda lineup for ten years, with sales totaling over 400,000 in its life span.

3/ Freddie also has the distinction of being the first ever 350cc World Champion in 1949 when, he won all five events of the inaugural campaign.

5/ Born James Sherwin Ekins in Hollywood, California, Bud Ekins is known to most as the actor who jumped the fence on a disguised Triumph TR6 Trophy 650cc motorcycle in *The Great Escape*. He rode a 650cc Triumph TR6 Trophy, as did Steve McQueen, in the USA International Six Day Trial team for 1964 held in East Germany.

He received a gold medal at the 1962 International Six Days Trials in East Germany, and was part of the US ISDT team of 1964 with John Steen, Cliff Coleman, Dave Ekins, and Steve McQueen. In 1965, again on Triumphs, the team competed at the ISDT on the Isle of Man, McQueen being replaced by Ed Kretz, Jr.

6/ From the 790s until the Norman Invasion in 1066, the Milford Haven estuary was used occasionally by Vikings looking for shelter. During one visit likely to be in 878 on his way to the Battle of Cynuit, the Viking Chieftain Hubba wintered in the Haven with 23 ships

7/ Lee - Cultivating cannabis, Lingham - Importation of Cocaine, Ashkanazi - "Internet related" offences

8/ Davidstow Circuit is a disused motor racing circuit and airfield built in Cornwall, in the United Kingdom. The circuit was built on the site of a World War II RAF Coastal Command base, RAF Davidstow Moor, opened in 1942. Davidstow circuit opened in 1952, and held three Formula 1 races between 1954 and 1955. The circuit hosted its last race in 1955, and was one of many of Britain's airfields to be transformed into motor racing venues. Davidstow circuit is notable for the first victory in a Formula One race by a Lotus.

9/ Münch is a German motorcycle manufacturer. The engine was originally a 1,000 cc four cylinder air cooled NSU car engine, single overhead cam, the transmission was from Horex.
